When using filtered seawater

The station is equipped with in-building supply of filtered seawater. Seawater from Limfjorden is pumped in from a position c. 400 m southwest of Rønbjerg harbour, filtered through an in-building sand-filter and finally stored in a large below-ground tank. From here, the filtered seawater can be distributed through PVC pipes to multiple outlet taps in wet-labs and cold rooms. There are also outlet taps supplying the out-door tank area. Note that operating these two seawater systems pumps is NOT self-service. If you need filtered seawater, contact the local caretaker, Per Hansen (mobile +45 29939628), or Kim N. Mouritsen in order to get help and/or thorough instructions. If these instructions are not followed, you may be met with claims for damages.
