



Applied bat research at AU Ecoscience

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Biodiversity and species monitoring is a vital management tool and can be approached in many ways, including trapping of animals or less invasive means such as camera traps or acoustic recordings. In my talk, I will provide an overview of bat monitoring in Denmark and of ongoing applied research projects undertaken at Ecoscience to support monitoring of the Danish bat fauna, including the use of IR beam counters and camera traps in Mønsted limestone mine to facilitate and partially automate population estimates of bat species that use this important winter hibernaculum.
